

Web of Life Permaculture Design Course



March 5th to April 30 (no class March 26 for Spring Break)
Thursdays - 7:30 to ~9 PM

Eight week short course introduces students to permaculture concepts including:

- Soil building
- On-site water retention
- Pollinator and other beneficial insects
- Plant polycultures
- Plant layering
- Tasting of uncommon perennial crops
- Introduction to leading practitioners in this worldwide movement.

Goal: Through a dual track of lecture and hands-on design over the eight weeks, students will develop a do-able project. Individuals focusing on the church gardens may also want to develop parallel plans for their own homes, while others may want to focus solely on their home gardens.

Cost: \$175/family unit. With at least 12 registrants, cost drops to \$150/family
