


We are not very racially diverse

But we are more diverse on income and in other ways



Top 5 reasons we attend Sunday services (in order of endorsement)



Participation in Our Community is Both Broad and Deep


How we participate in the Church Community Outside of Sunday Morning Worship (at least 30% of members said they did these activities in the last year)

What We View as Church Strengths (top 10 from list of 33 items)




