Expanded explanation:

- Engage our community both internally and externally with sensitivity to inclusivity and healing. Inclusivity pertains to many kinds of diversity, including political, religious, age, gender/orientation, and more. Sensitivity toward healing includes acknowledgment of past pains, grief, and trauma, as well as the vital impulse to recover and to progress forward.
- Harness the congregation's creativity to build a robust fiscal future. Engaging the congregation to solve the budget problem in many small and large ways: fund-raising; community dinners; (for example, \$5 to attend to make Christmas ornaments).
- Enhance church communication strategies through a multi-pronged approach to ensure that the right messages get to the right people at the right time. Utilize even more methods to communicate, as identified by peoples' expressed needs.
